Clinical Clearance Requirements by Graduate Program

Requirements common to all graduate nursing programs:

- Annual Criminal Background Check (one time only for NED)
- Immunizations
- Annual TB test
- Annual Physical (one time only for NED and CNM)
- One time TB Fit Test (Mask)
- Current BLS certification
- DC RN License

Additional ACNP and CCNS Requirements:

- ACLS certification
- CCRN or PCCN or CEN certification
- DC residents must obtain MD RN licensure; VA or MD residents must obtain RN licensure from their state of residence

Additional CNM Requirements:

- DC residents must obtain MD RN licensure; VA or MD residents must obtain RN licensure from their state of residence

Additional CRNA Requirements:

- Annual drug screening

Additional FNP Requirements:

- DC residents must obtain MD RN licensure; VA or MD residents must obtain RN licensure from their state of residence
